The anti-ragging cell members of ASIET present were welcomed by the Principal. The principal insisted the faculty and students present to spread the message about the functioning of this cell to the other students and faculty in the campus.

The Principal addressed about the pros and cons of the ragging.

The sub inspector of police from Kaldy police station Sri Sudheer pointed out that there is no discrimination as senior or junior in this aspect and the punishments they have to undergo if found guilty. He also informed the students the after effect of the ragging and even the probability of leading to death. Even body shaming is also included in ragging and also appreciated that no such incidents were reported from this College.

The ward member Sri. Eldhose pointed out the areas/situation in which we have to concentrate to curb ragging. It can be implemented only through the combined effort of the faculty and students.

The media person Sri Prasanth also shared that even small incidents which we will not think will lead to a very serious issue if reported in the portal. Also requested to students to report anything happens in the college to the concern authority without failure.

Sri. Sreenath N, GM pointed out the after effect of the reported incidents if any which will spoil their entire future.

Sri. Sijo George, NGO Officer discussed about the transformation in the character of the students when transferred from school life to college life. Also requested the



student representatives to be precautious so that no such untoward incidents happens inside the campus.
